Tincup Wilderness Lodge embraces modernity, while still remaining true to its traditions

Tincup Wilderness Lodge occupies a paradise of its own, far away from civilisation of any kind. The lodge has a long and eventful history behind it. The passion its new owner has for the place will ensure that the story will continue, with plenty of excitement still to come.

A sensitive, stylistically assured modernisation

Over the last few years, a lot has been happening on the shore of Tincup Lake, in the West of Canada's Yukon Territory. Under the skilled supervision of its new owner, Meinrad Humm, Tincup Wilderness Lodge has been completely renovated and modernised. The main house, with its large veranda built of Canadian cedar wood, has been extended, and now boasts a completely new kitchen. The Tincup Wilderness Lodge compound has gained two new storage and facility outhouses. All the units on the site, which are also built of cedar wood, have been given new shower units, lavatories and washstands. The lighting has also been upgraded, with modern LED units providing pleasing and relaxing light. Light, in this case from the sun, is also what generates all the Lodge's electricity, thanks to a new solar-power installation. Great emphasis has been placed on ensuring that the quality and design of the renovated structure are truly special. Most of the new furniture has been commissioned exclusively for Tincup Lodge and is made of solid oak. It is ideally complemented by a collection of oil paintings by an artist living in the Yukon.

A true logistical challenge

Making sure all the required materials arrived exactly when they were needed required meticulous logistical arrangements. In all, some 100 tonnes of material were brought in by various types of aeroplane and helicopter. That in turn meant that each individual flight, the freight it was carrying and the individual tasks being carried out on the site all needed to be perfectly dovetailed with each other.

The ideal place for an unforgettable stay

Tincup Wilderness Lodge offers its guests a truly memorable place to stay, with a wide range of leisure activities to pursue, from fishing and hiking to canoeing, kayaking and photography. None are compulsory, of course, and many guests are content simply to relax and recharge their batteries. The Lodge has an enviable reputation not only for its excellent fishing rights, but also for its delicious, authentic Northern food. A separate sauna building with a new wood-fire-heated *hot tub* and its own generously proportioned veranda is located right at the lake's edge. Guests are also welcome to avail themselves of a plethora of modern outdoor equipment, including aluminium-hulled boats, canoes, kayaks, life jackets, and GPS-enabled walkie talkies.

The season at Tincup Wilderness Lodge lasts from mid June to mid September each year. In order to ensure that guests enjoy plenty of privacy in an environment where they can feel truly at home, the Lodge welcomes no more than 8 to 10 guests each week.
